



Chapter Philanthropic Work - Most Monies per Member and Most Hours per Member

First, second and third place awards will be presented to the chapter donating Most Monies per member and Most Hours per member.

The chapter member count after March 31st shall be determined by the print-out sent from ESA Headquarters to the State Membership Director who shall provide a copy to the State Philanthropic Chairman.

Entries must be submitted on the Philanthropic Award form provided by the **State Awards Director** and 4 copies mail to Philanthropic Chair postmarked by April 15th.

Three of the copies will be used for judging and 1 copy used for compiling state information on the State Council Philanthropic Report and Awards Entry form provided by International Council. International Council Awards Entry must be postmarked by June 10th.

Top Three State Money and Top Three State Hours Award Winners should be submitted by the State Philanthropic Chair to the International Council Philanthropic Chair on the Philanthropic Service Awards form and postmarked by June 15th.

Philanthropic Summary Award of Excellence

This award has been initiated to recognize the chapter with overall excellent philanthropic work and participation at all levels of ESA.

First, second, and third place awards will be presented and a traveling silver bowl will be presented to the first place winner by the Georgia State Council.

The Philanthropic Award Form will be judged (using the following judging sheet) to determine the winners.

- 1. Form is signed by Philanthropic Chair and Certified by Chapter President. (5 pts) _____
- 2. Each line listing a project is completed for monies and/or hours. (5 pts) _____
- 3. Date of events provided. Must fall within reporting dates. (5 pts) _____
- 4. Projects are not duplicated between categories. (15 pts) _____
 Example: Hope for Hero's hours and monies should only show at International Level Projects and not be duplicated in the State or Chapter area of form, since doing so will duplicate the total hours and monies reported.
- 5. Number of International Projects showing participation: (up to 15 pts) _____
 - a. 8 projects – 15 pts
 - b. 7 projects – 12 pts
 - c. 6 projects – 10 pts
 - d. 5 projects – 7 pts
 - e. 1-4 projects – 5 pts
- 6. Did chapter participate in State Project Remembered Patient? (5 pts) _____
- 7. Did chapter participate in State Project Georgia Parks (friends of parks)? (5 pts) _____
- 8. Was the chapter an all-around chapter or did they put their work into just one area of Philanthropic work? (30 pts) _____
- 9. Did chapter participate with other organizations to complete any philanthropic projects? (15) _____
